

Sight Words: Once your child knows all of the words on the two lists- please record them reading them and email it to me. Don't worry about sending a video until your child is ready. Feel free to do one list at a time too. They have the rest of the school year. If you are having trouble attaching it to an email, let me know, we can zoom or you can use the app loom or instant messenger, whatever works best for you.

Reading: If your child is in a hardcover book, please have them read two stories a week. If your child is solely reading individual AR books, use Epic or books from home for your child to read. You can check if a book is AR on ARbookfinder. Please have your child take an AR test. Some stories in the hardcover book are AR as well. Email me if you need AR username and password

Writing: If your child is struggling with writing, here are two ideas: Do a pass along story- you write a sentence, they write a sentence, you write a sentence and so on- this will help to make a more detailed story, or you if they are struggling to come up with ideas you can do a roll a story, where they roll a die and pick from a sheet of choices for a character, setting and problem. I included a few examples in the packet if you choose to use one and I shared an electronic one as well on Friday. If you use the electronic one make sure to **MAKE A COPY** of it before you manipulate the sheet (go to file, make copy, rename it) or else it will change the document for everyone. :) These are just ideas, they are optional suggestions.
